

4-2.1 PROTESTS: If an OSS/ASA member who is a competitor believes that another competitor has obtained a significant unfair competitive advantage by some action that the member believes is in violation of the OSS/ASA rules, the member may protest such action. The protest must be made in writing by the competitor (or his/her crew chief if the competitor is on the race track) within 30 minutes after the checkered flag of that event is displayed. The protest must be presented to the Head Technical Inspector. A cash protest fee shall accompany each separate protest, however, the protest amount will be the winning purse amount for that division that night. There will also be an administrative fee assessed to any protest, that amount will be determined by the Race Director and be decided on a case by case basis. Any protest shall be for ONE (1) RULE ONLY, if there is more than ONE (1) it will be ruled as a separate protest and a separate envelope and fee will be required. A \$200.00 cash protest fee shall accompany each separate "NON DRIVE TRAIN" protest. Officials will decide whether the manner is protestable, and if so shall decide the protest as promptly as possible, and shall inform the parties to the protest of the decision. The protest is only between the 2 parties involved and OSS/ASA OFFICIALS. Officials may decline a protest, even if the matter is protestable, if he determines that the alleged rule violation is so insubstantial as to not provide the competitor with a significant competitive advantage. The decision that the matter is not protestable is final and non-appealable. In deciding the matter, Officials may take whatever action is appropriate to further the interests of fairness and finality in competition results. Such action includes, but is not limited to, revising the official race results, imposing penalties (disqualification, suspension or fines, and/or loss of finishing positions in the event), awarding or subtracting points or taking no action. Protests can not be filed or will not be accepted for the last two point races of your division.
